THE BATTLE OF WATERLOO AND WHY NAPOLEON LOST.

To begin the attack Napoleon always directed his cavalry to strike at a particular point of the enemy line. This was followed by sending his infantry through the breach and then attacking the flanks of the separated line. What Napoleon did not know, however, was that there was an unseen sunken road between his cavalry and the enemy line. This charge was a bloody catastrophe. Men and horses fell head over heels into that sunken road followed by others. Thus, there was no breach in the enemy line for the infantry to find. Also, the British had bored rifles that improved the accuracy of rifle fire at a distance. The French only had smooth bored rifles that required close encounters to be effective. When the German cavalry showed up to support the British, Napoleon's mighty military force was overwhelmed and defeated.



A German artist by the name of Albert Reich (1881-1942) created this series. He was a graphic artist in WWI and later became a pro-nazi supporter in WWII. After his death Hitler made him a professor for designing a series of propaganda posters and postcards. We think that he portrayed the savagery of war rather than the glory quite well.

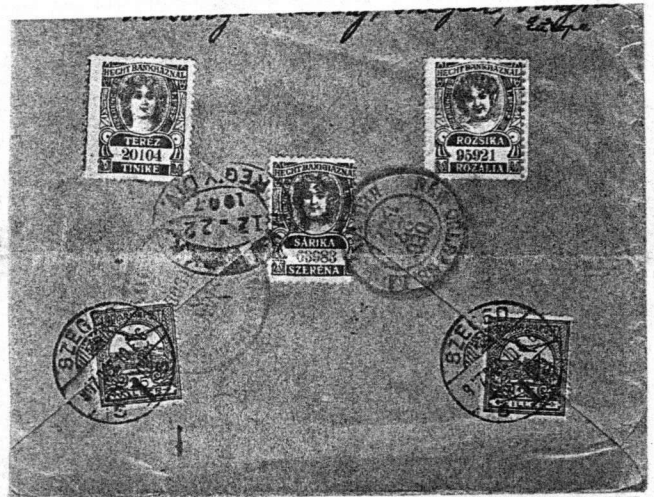
AN UNUSUAL THEORY

Victor Berkovia recalls that about 10 to 15 years ago in Atlanta, he observed an stamp exhibit where "Lady's Stamps" were described by the exhibitor as "accountancy labels for prostitutes." This is an intriguing theory, no doubt wrong, but it did attempt to explain the purpose of the 'lady stamps.'



Victor has provided us with two covers that were mailed from Hungary in 1907 to Costa Rica that show transit tied cancelled labels by way of New Orleans and New York. The "lady labels" were used to seal the covers.

We are still waiting for a definitive answer concerning what these labels were really all about.

THE ONLY CURE FOR THE POSTER STAMP ITCH: *KEEP SCRATCHING!*

We came to poster stamps in a roundabout way. We share our home with Scottish deerhounds, so we started haunting paper shows in search of deerhound ephemera — mostly postcards and trading cards. We saw a picture of a deerhound cinderella from the Scottish isle of Eynhallow and became obsessed with finding one. Dealers at stamp shows would shake their heads when they saw us coming. Then a member of the Rose City Stamp Club of Portland came up with one in a sheet of eight dogs — for 40 cents!

From there it was a short hop to postage stamps featuring dogs — all breeds, not just deerhounds. We joined the Dogs On Stamps Study Unit and spotted a small ad in the DOSSU newsletter promising something called “Poster Stamps.” We had no idea what they were, so we asked to see some — with dogs, of course. We received color copies of a dozen album sheets. The stamps knocked us for a loop! This was in 2003.

We joined eBay in 2005 and added to our collection, but the Poster Stamp itch really didn't hit until a year later when we bought a dog stamp from a new seller and asked if she had any more. Did she ever! She had just purchased a huge collection that included several hundred dogs. We bought them all in four budget-sized bites — for a pittance, based on the price-per-stamp we've paid since. From then on, there was no stopping us. We itched all over.

We were sure we would soon exhaust the supply. How many dog poster stamps could there possibly be? Twelve years later, we have a pretty good idea: Bazillions! We know that our collection, which now numbers about 2,000, represents the tip of the iceberg.

Dog show stamps alone account for 244 of our total. Here are examples from complete sets, along with a few singles.

We try to be selective, quelling our urge to own every variation of a particular stamp, but on occasion we break the rule. A case in point is the ubiquitous yellow Gramophone stamp, with Nipper listening attentively to “his master’s voice.” We have it with imprints in four languages, and always keep an eye out for new ones. Gramophone stamps of all types number 26.

We can only conclude from the wide range of products with dogs on their poster stamps that a) manufacturers and retailers love dogs, b) manufacturers and retailers know their customers love dogs, c) advertising artists love dogs, or d) all of the above. Peter Johann Werth is a great example of an artist who snuck dogs in wherever he could.

Chocolate makers account for 139 stamps in our collection. Others products with lesser numbers include dog food, shoe polish, margarine, automobiles, bicycles and beer. Here are a few select advertisers.



We think we have a sheep and a couple of stray cats among our many dogs. (They *look* like dogs.) And for a time we let matchbox labels distract us from our sworn mission. But we're focused now. As Admiral David Farragut so aptly proclaimed during the Battle of Mobile Bay, "Damn the torpedoes! Full-speed ahead!"

So the hunt continues. Not a day goes by that isn't dedicated, in part, to satisfying our consuming desire for poster stamps: searching, buying, bidding, paying, arranging and re-arranging album pages, corresponding, maintaining files, and kicking back and admiring.

Some people say there aren't enough hours in a day. Since we started scratching our itch, we've determined there aren't enough years in a lifetime. Think of it — *bazillions* of dog stamps exist out there, just waiting to join the ranks and files in our burgeoning albums. We want them all, and we want them *now!*

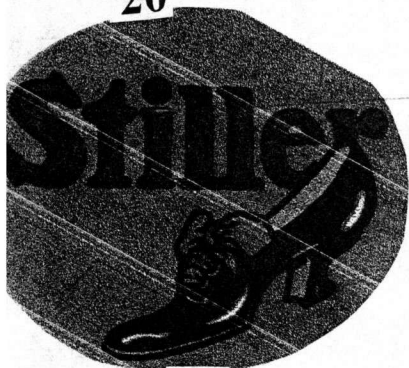

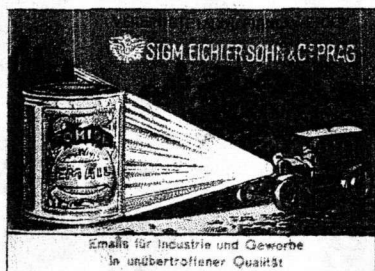
